

Audition Information

Monday 11th June 7:45 pm: First meeting to prepare for auditions and you must also sign up for a 10 minute slot for the auditions

Wednesday 20th June 7:00 pm – 10 pm: Auditions

- For non-members there is an audition fee of £10 which will be taken off your membership fee should you be successful in your auditions.
- If cast, you will be asked to hire the script for £10 and you will be required to be available for rehearsals and show week for all dates between 23rd to 29th September 2018.
- Rehearsals on Mondays and Wednesdays.

Character Breakdown

Playing ages are given as a guideline but mainly, characters will need to fit together age-wise.

Seymour Krelborn (25-35)

Male, Lead, Tenor - An insecure, put-upon florist's clerk and eventual hero. He is a genuine, well-meaning man who is taken for granted because of his clumsy ways and poor social skills.

Audrey (25-35)

Female, Lead, Mezzo-Soprano - Bleached-blond secret love of Seymour's life. She has poor self-worth and education, but incredibly good looks and a sweet and vulnerable demeanour. Strong acting/comedy and singing.

Voice of Audrey II (offstage)

Male, Supporting, Baritone - An actor/vocalist located offstage. The voice is that of a conniving, street-smart 'villain.' A funky Rhythm and Blues voice is best.

Audrey II (puppeteer)

Supporting, Silent - Puppeteers the plant through its various stages of its growth.

Skidettes: Crystal, Ronnette, Chiffon (any age)

Female, Supporting, Mezzo-Soprano - Crystal, Ronnette and Chiffon are street urchins, acting as the occasional Greek Chorus. Fresh, hip, and smart, these girls are the only ones who have a grip on reality.

Orin Scrivello, D.D.S. (30-50)

Male, Supporting, Baritone - An egotistical dentist with a passion for leather and sadistic tendencies. Audrey's abusive boyfriend, who is targeted by Seymour.

Mr. Mushnik (40-60)

Male, Supporting, Baritone - The seasoned owner of the failing East Side flower shop and Seymour's nosy boss. He is profit-driven, greedy, and manipulative.

Ensemble (various ages)

Since this will be a small cast, the ensemble will play an active role in the production. The minor roles will be fulfilled by members of the ensemble.
